






#### Who We Are

Supportive Housing Communities (SHC) provides permanent supportive housing for men, women and families overcoming homelessness, especially veterans and those with mental illness, substance abuse and medical or other disabling conditions. SHC is a local leader for ending homelessness among our most vulnerable members. Through our work in the community we have helped find housing for hundreds of our most vulnerable neighbors amongst us.

As of July 31, 2024, there are 3,080 individuals experiencing homelessness in Charlotte-Mecklenburg. This total includes 1,754 single individuals, 133 unaccompanied youth, 337 households with minor children (totaling 1,115 people), and 44 families with multiple adults (totaling 84 people). Included in the total of 3,080 individuals, 167 are homeless Veterans, and 746 (577 in February) are individuals who are experiencing chronic homelessness.

#### What This Campaign is About

As an end of the year fundraising campaign, in place of the annual Neighbor of the Year event, Meet Your Neighbor looks to share authentic stories of the different needs of our clients. During the month of November, Homeless Awareness Month, we will be publishing and promoting eight stories of our neighbors that speak to the struggles, journey, and hope theyhave experienced in their life and what SHC is doing to alleviate homelessness and human suffering for Charlotte's most vulnerable neighbors.

Clients who have found themselves homeless due to physical injury and or disabilities that have caused hardship.




Clients who have found themselves without a place to live due to the challenges of mental disabilities. These vulnerable neighbors require more assistance and to be taught basic life skills.


